- Potted plants

CLEAN RAIN GUTTERS AND DRAINS REGULARLY

MAINTAIN GUTTERS

Rain gutters are able to hold stagnant water with debris, making them the perfect place for mosquitoes to grow.

REPAIR DAMAGED SCREENS

FIX SCREENS

Maintain screens on windows and doors in order to prevent mosquitoes from getting into your home.





CHANGE THE WATER IN PET DRINKING BOWLS AND BIRD BATHS

DUMP WATER

Dumping old water and adding new water frequently (at least twice per week) helps prevent mosquitoes from growing and emerging as biting adults.

ELIMINATE HIDING SPOTS IN YOUR YARD

UNCOVER HIDING AREAS

Regular trimming of grasses and weeds in and around low places in your yard prevents mosquitoes from using these areas to hide.
