

Also known as mosquito fish, these freshwater fish are used as a biological tool to help control mosquitoes by eating the mosquitoes in the larval stage. The fish can live 2 to 3 years and are able to tolerate a wide range of temperatures.

Mosquito fish are about 1/4 inch in length when born and can grow to a maximum length of about 3 inches. As soon as they are born, they are ready to go to work! A single adult mosquito fish can eat up to 500 mosquito larvae per day!

> Gambusia are perfect for water bodies without natural flow or predators. Ornamental ponds, unused swimming pools, animal water troughs, and ditches may all benefit from a mosquito fish treatment.
